Engleking's Country Beef Shop

The Engleking name has been associated with farming and dairy since 1937. In addition to providing the highest quality all-natural beef, they also offer all-natural pork products from the Berkshire breed which also provides a very high quality meat.

Rivoli Theatre

The revival of the Rivoli Theatre could be a catalyst for revitalization on Indianapolis's east side. The movie house brought Hollywood glamour to East 10th Street when it opened in 1927. Now, the facility is in need of major repairs. The collapsed roof over the auditorium has been replaced, but funds are now needed to replace the collapsed roof over the storefronts. If not replaced by winter, it may be past the point of saving.
