Nicey Treat

Every time owner Jeff Patrick and his brothers would visit his Grandparents' house, their first priority was to go straight to the freezer to see what frozen fruit treats were waiting for them. While vacationing in Mexico Jeff was reminded of the sense of excitement and joy that those frozen treats brought and when he returned to the states he began a search for frozen pops that featured unique flavors and all-natural ingredients. Having no success he and his wife decided to make their own. Thus, Nicey Treat was born!

Blue River Natural Foods

The Smith dairy farm of 167 acres has been in the family since 1948. Earl Smith grew up on the farm and went into partnership with his dad upon graduating from high school. Michael, the youngest son of Earl and Barb Smith, is now running the dairy. They have diversified and are now raising chickens and hogs as well as raising some produce. The dairy was the first Grade A Dairy Farm in Hancock County and is one of the only 2 dairies left in the county.

The Benton House

The Benton House is located at 312 S. Downey Avenue. Built in 1873, it is now maintained through the volunteer support of The Benton House Association under the administration of the Irvington Historic Landmarks Foundation. This ten-room brick house has fine woodwork and oak floors and was restored and furnished as a cultural, historical, social and civic center for community use. The house can be rented for events such as showers, meetings, small weddings, etc.
